- She WAS a victim. Today she IS a Leader and Executive Youth Officer for her own 501(c)(3) Nonprofit Organization working to support her peers that have also been impacted by childhood abuse and trauma.

2021 THE GRASS ROOTS


• Team Only Stronger began their mission with a Launch event that took place on March 13, 2021, at Drips Coffee in La Jolla where over 75 community supporters gathered to listen and speak up about the importance of connectedness and our goals to build a Team of community champions to fight against the stigma of childhood abuse and trauma.

• Team Only Stronger began their efforts to increase resilience with an idea to provide peer support to child victims of abuse through a digital support initiative where they provided 300+ fidget/pop-it toys; QR coded with a video message of empowerment from Arienne to children that might be taking the stand in court against their abusers just like she did; in collaboration with the SD District Attorney Office, Victim Services Division.


